- Scheduled for Sept Oct levelling, drainage, irrigation also fix mistakes with field 1
- Council unable to get responses to tender, negotiating with contractor
- Irrigation work will clash with Ramp construction

#### Access Ramp

- \$20k received from CBPP, Sports Council \$4k not received
- Contractors' meeting held on site to finalise details ready for construction, Council rep did not attend,
  Irrigation contractor indicated clash in projects NOT NOTIFIED by Council.
- o Ramp on hold until field renovations completed
- Aim to get Council to build ramp while doing field renovation
